DESCRIPTION

Selleys Craft Glue is a PVA emulsion adhesive specially formulated for quick adhesion for craft work. The product is an offwhite paste which is clear when dry.

SIZES AVAILABLE

Selleys Craft Glue is available in a 60mL & 120mL bottle only.

USES

Selleys Craft Glue is suitable for use on fabrics, felt, cardboard. Leather, suede, wood, paper and plastic films (other than polyethylene and polypropylene)

TECHNICAL DETAILS

Selleys Craft Glue is a water based PVA copolymer adhesive.

Viscosity: 8000 –14000 cps Specific Gravity: 1.0 –1.1

HOW TO USE

- Ensure surfaces to be joined are clean, dust and lint free. Shake bottle well before use. Unscrew cap to expose nozzle.
- Apply a thin coat of Selleys Craft Glue to one surface and press together. Hold in position with light pressure for a few seconds, or longer for very absorbent surfaces.

CLEAN UP

Clean up excess glue quickly with a damp cloth. Wipe nozzle clean and replace cap after use.

LIMITATIONS

On very porous or open weave fabrics extra adhesive may be required for optimum bond strength.

In very cold or damp conditions the adhesive is slower setting.

WARNINGS/FIRST AID

Craft Glue is considered to be a low hazard material. In case of eye contact flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes.
